

Reference Guide -Package Travel and LTA Regulations 2019

The travel services are combined by the trader before a **single contract** for all services is concluded

В

The travel services are combined in **one** of the following five ways (irrespective if there are separate contracts with each provider):

С

A traveller selects and pays for two types of travel service on a single visit to a business's point of sale



A business 'facilitates in a targeted manner' the procurement of at least one additional travel service from another business where the second contract is concluded not later than 24 hours after the confirmation of the booking of the first travel service

This is a package

- i. selected before payment and purchased from a single point of sale
- ii. offered/sold/charged at an inclusive or total price
- iii. advertised as a 'package' or similar term
- iv. combined after the conclusion of a contract where a trader entitles the traveller to choose among a selection of different types of travel service
- v. purchased from separate traders through linked online booking processes where the traveller's name, payment details and e-mail address are transmitted from the first trader to the second trader and the second contract is concluded not later than 24 hours after the confirmation of the booking of the first travel service

This is a package

This is a **linked travel arrangement**

*There is no package or LTA if the combination of travel services consists of a travel service (e.g. carriage of passengers, accommodation or vehicle rental) and an 'other tourist service' where the 'other tourist service' accounts for less than 25% of the value of the combination or does not otherwise constitute an 'essential feature' of the combination
