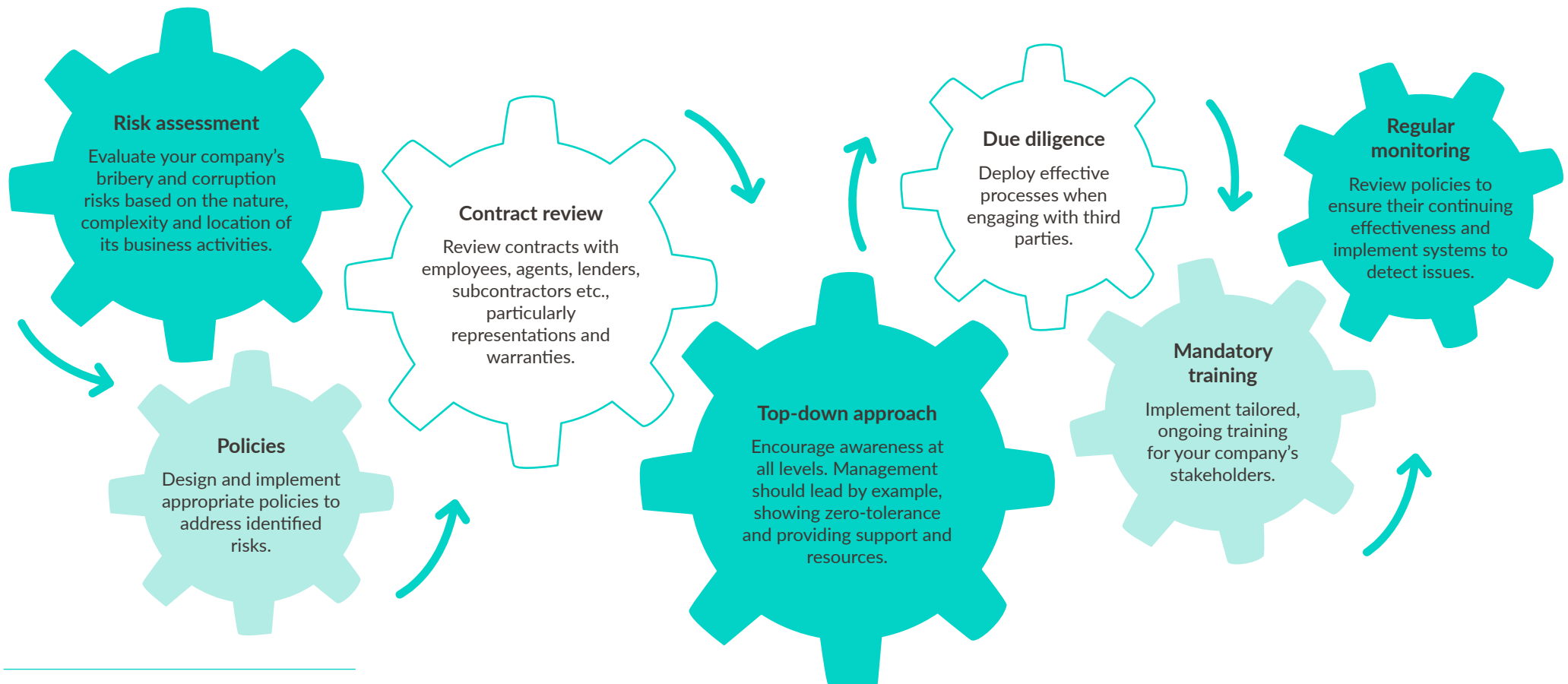
Preparing for new Irish anti-corruption legislation

New legislation has been passed by the Irish Parliament and will soon be commenced. Irish companies, particularly those doing business in high corruption risk countries, and companies operating in Ireland should be prepared.

How can your company protect itself?

Under the Act, companies can be held liable for bribery or corruption offences committed by employees, officers, agents or subsidiaries unless they can prove that they took **all reasonable steps** and exercised all **due diligence** to prevent such offences. Mandatory reporting obligations may also apply.
